Seeing God

Epiphany is the season of the church year when we focus on "seeing God" in the people and events of our lives. When I think of Epiphany, I think of a Buddhist story about seeing in a different way. Here is the story:

One day a farmer's only horse disappeared. His neighbors all came to commiserate with him on his bad luck, but the farmer just said, "Bad luck? Good luck? Who knows?"

A week or so later, the farmer's horse returned, accompanied by two wild horses. The farmer's neighbors all came by to congratulate him on his good luck, but the farmer just said, "Good luck? Bad luck? Who knows?"

The farmer's son decided to break the wild horses so they could be ridden. One of the horses threw him and broke his leg. The neighbors came by to console the farmer for this stroke of bad luck, but the farmer just said, "Bad luck? Good luck? Who knows?"


A few days later, the king's army came to the village. They took all the able-bodied young men to fight in a war. They left the farmer's son because he had a broken leg. The neighbors all came by to congratulate the farmer on his good luck, but the farmer just said, "Good luck? Bad luck? Who knows?"

The story reminds me of Romans 8:28, which reads, "For all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to God's purpose." What a wonderful promise! These words change our perspective on the events of our lives and in our world. No matter what happens God is always, always working to bring good out of it.

So, where do you see God working to bring good into your life, into Grace, into McGregor, into the world? And where can YOU join God in that work for the sake of the world? That is God's commission for us as baptized ones. That is God's invitation to us as the church.
