Building & Property Report:

This spring and summer has been very busy for the Building & Property Team as we set out to start and finish multiple projects at Grace. After the bathrooms were remodeled, kitchen walls painted and counters replaced, the team began to work on other prioritized projects. First on the list was to determine what to do with the rotting log siding on the north wall of the sanctuary exterior. The team removed the existing siding and ordered new steel half log siding to match the other wood exterior siding. The cross window showed signs of its 40 year age and was also ordered for replacement. We are contracting for the installation of the siding, window, and removal/reinstallation of the stain glass cross. This project is expected to be completed by September. The parking lot has been resurfaced with tar and stone during July and looks great! Additionally, the team will be working on scraping and painting the chips and cracks on the Old Log Church; repairing or replacing the deck and stairs to the Old Log Church; and building and installing a railing on the Reformation Hall south exit stairs. All of these projects have been made possible by an endowment from member Lois Welsh who determined before her death that the money was to be used to fix the church. We have received other endowments as well and thank those who help us to maintain God's house. We could not have done any of these projects if we had to rely on our General Fund. Thanks also goes out to all of the volunteers and generous supporters.
