These thoughts brought to mind 2 Timothy 4:2, "Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage - with great patience and careful instruction."

Building & Property September Report

The summer months have flown by and our list of projects have some unfinished items but we have made significant progress towards the most important on our list. As of this writing, we are in process to completing the painting of the Old Log Church by volunteers and are awaiting the contractor to complete the window and siding replacement on the exterior north wall of the Sanctuary. The kitchen and bathroom remodeling is completed. Replacement of the 25 year old refrigerator and dish washer in the parsonage has been done. The stoop exiting the South side of the Reformation Hall/Sunday School now sports a railing. The lawn has been cut and maintained all summer by volunteers. A new message sign was installed so that we can announce services and events along with Bible quotes. We now can drive on a freshly sealed blacktop parking lot. Much of this work has been done by volunteers and the cost of many of these projects were paid for by an endowment from, among others, the estate of Lois Welsh who wanted the money to be used to improve and maintain the church. We could not have accomplished much of this without the endowments as we are still close to break-even with our General Fund. Thank you to all who help to preserve and improve God's House with your support.
